Marabu - Biocompatibility

The biocompatibility of a material refers to its ability not to induce negative effects and no adverse reactions at the molecular and cellular level in/on the human organism. Printing inks in their liquid form, such as the Marabu products manufactured in Tamm (Germany) or Bietigheim-Bissingen (Germany), are not used directly in or on the human organism but rather applied to articles which may come into such contact. A biocompatibility examination must instead be done with the finished printed article performed with the fully cured/dried ink. An examination of the biocompatibility of the liquid ink alone thus would provide no useful data.

We as the ink manufacturer are not in a position to determine or control the defined article or the parameters and processing of the corresponding article. As each article and processing of article results with its own biocompatibility, a blanket statement of conformity is neither possible nor helpful.

A test for biocompatibility must always be done for each finished printed article by the corresponding parts producer.
